## **CITY PROJECTS**

The City Fire Department has received a \$15, 000 grant from the State of California and 3,000 from FEMA for 6 new Fire Truck radios.

An application for a seven home subdivision on 6<sup>th</sup> Street and Gaswell Road has been approved by the Planning Commission.

The City is discussing acquiring the Isleton Water Tower. The facility is owned by CAL-AM Water and are planning its removal.

The City has received a grant to prepare an emergency flood response plan for \$250,000.

The City will begin evening Sheriff patrols in December of this year.

The Del Rio Hotel has been closed due to building and housing violations. The owners are working to reopen this building.
