**City of Isleton**  
**Housing Element Update**

The City of Isleton is conducting an update to the Housing Element. The Housing Element, part of the City's General Plan, is a policy document that addresses existing and future housing needs for all Clearlake residents and economic groups. The State of California requires by law that the Housing Element be updated periodically.

The City conducted several previous public workshops and hearings on the update document and the City Council adopted it on September 9, 2021. However, the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) declined final approval of the document requesting amendments to it to comply with some technical compliance requirements with State Housing Law. The document was then amended to address these technical requirements. This revised Housing Element Draft is available for review at the link below.
