**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ISLETON
SETTING PERMIT FEES FOR THE PERSONAL CULTIVATION OF CANNABIS**

WHEREAS, in 1996, the voters of California approved Proposition 215, known as the Compassionate Use Act of 1996 ("CUA"), allowing the medical use of marijuana and establishing an affirmative defense for certain marijuana-related criminal offenses; and

WHEREAS, in 2004, the Medical Marijuana Program Act ("MMPA") was approved by the state legislature, providing a criminal defense to qualified patients and their primary caregivers who possessed marijuana within the limits set forth in the MMPA; and

WHEREAS, in 2015, the Legislature adopted the Medical Marijuana Regulation and Safety Act ("MMRSA"), which addressed state licensing with respect to medical marijuana cultivation, dispensing, and manufacturing; and

WHEREAS, on November 8, 2016, the voters of the State of California approved Proposition 64, the Adult Use of Marijuana Act ("AUMA"), legalizing the recreational use of cannabis for adults 21 years of age and older; and

WHEREAS, California law allows cities to regulate cannabis pursuant to their respective police powers and land use authority; and

WHEREAS, City of Isleton Ordinance No. 2018-01 authorizes the personal cultivation of cannabis pursuant to a permit, and allows the City Council to establish a permit fee by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Isleton as follows:

Section 1: RecitalsThe City Council finds and determines that all of the above recitals are true and correct.

Section 2: Permit FeesThe City Council hereby establishes that the fee to obtain a permit pursuant to Article 23 ("CANNABIS LAND USE REGULATIONS"), Section 2302, Subsection C shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00).

Section 3: Effective DateThis resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
