CITY PROJECTS

The City has been awarded a \$250,000 grant to prepare an Emergency Flood Plan. This Plan is to provide for City emergency operations and training flood preparation.

The Brannan-Andrus District has received a \$22 million grant to repair levees along the Sacramento River.

The City's new Fire Truck will arrive the first week of September

Prop 68 Grant - Pubic Works Department fixed the leak on the ballfield at Wilson Park and rest improvements are being prepared. Construction is expected late this year.

The City is discussing acquiring the Isleton Water Tower. The facility is owned by CAL-AM Water and they want to take the tower out of use.
