

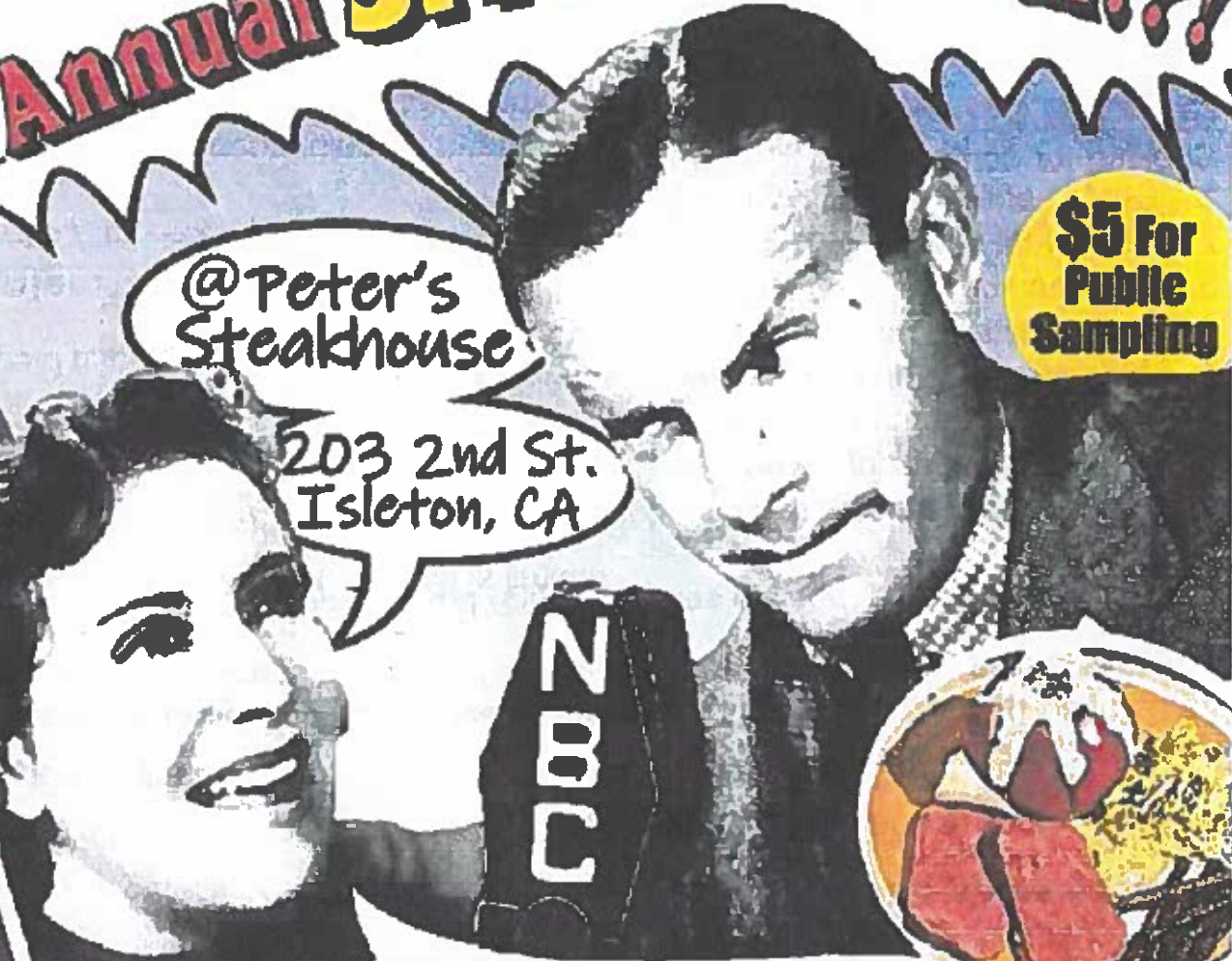

# 24th Annual Spam Festival

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## **Cooking contest rules:**

Cooking for contest starts at 10am

1. Cost to enter cooking contest \$20
2. Only meat used in dish is Spam. One dish per entry.
3. Dish may be prepared ahead of time and may be re-heated on site.
4. All contestants must submit their name and recipe when registering.
5. Judging will be on presentation, originality and taste.
6. All cook-off teams will be required to provide samples to the public and for judges. Prepare enough samples for approximately 50 people.
7. All contestants must bring own cooking devices. (No microwaves or toaster ovens allowed)
8. All dishes must be ready to serve by 12:00 pm for judging.

Space is limited. Up to 25 Contestants will be provided a space on a table. Table spaces will be numbered. Electrical outlets are limited, please state on your entry, whether or not you will need electrical source.

Winners will be announced after Spam Toss.

\$5 per person for public sampling

## **Spam eating contest rules:**

1. \$5 to enter – can pay day of event. Space is limited.
2. No drinking during eating of spam.
3. 1 – can of spam per contestant.
4. Contestant must completely finish a whole can of spam hands free no utensil assistance and show clear mouth before time is stopped and recorded.
5. Fee must be paid prior to eating contest.

## **Spam Toss Rules:**

1. \$10 per team entry fee – can pay day of event. Team names must be submitted 1 hour prior to toss.
2. Furthest caught toss wins (depending on number of entries there may be multiple heats)
3. Spam toss is scheduled immediately after spam eating contest.
4. Must be present at start of toss to get your toss time if multiple heats.
