PART TIME / TEMPORARY PUBLIC WORKS MAINTENANCE WORKER

DEFINITION

Public works laborers under supervision performs unskilled manual work and learn to operate light equipment and to perform a variety of semi-skilled road, drainage, and landscaping tasks.

TYPICAL TASKS

Shovel dirt, gravel and asphalt; cut brush; dig ditches; rake and spread gravel or paving material; load and unload trucks; flag traffic which involves dealing with the public; clear drainage ditches and culverts of debris from roadways; use a variety of hand tools; operate dump trucks, street striping and street sweeping machines to load trucks with asphalt or gravel; pave and patch roadways; spray drainage ditches and roadsides with herbicides; construct concrete forms for catch basins and retaining walls and perform related concrete work; paint traffic markings; install reflective markers on road surfaces; install sprinkler systems; plant shrubs and ground cover along roadsides; direct the work of extra-help and crews performing work such as picking up litter along roadsides, clearing brush from roadsides and stream beds, or weeding landscaped areas; may assist as crew members in tree trimming; learn to operate complex heavy equipment on a relief basis.
