The City has began enforcing the commercial district standards. These standards include no residential use in the front of commercial buildings.

The City has approved the provision of a new internet service provider – Unwired Broadband. This service will bring a significant improvement in internet service for the whole town. Service availability is to be announced.

The City renewed its appointment of Mrs. S. Gardiner to the Sacramento-Yolo Mosiquito Vector District.

CITY PROJECTS

Wilson Park Rehabilitation is under construction and will be unavailable to the public for approximately three months. Improvements include new playground equipment, park lighting, BBQ grills, small and large dog parks and skate park.

Property owners are reminded to register all rental properties with the City Rental Housing Inspection Program.

The City will be advertising for a consultant for the Isleton Emergency Flood Plan funded by the Department of Water Resources. This grant also allows the City to acquire equipment for preparedness and flood mitigation.
