CITY PROJECTS

Wilson Park Rehabilitation is under construction and will be unavailable to the public for approximately three months. Improvements include new playground equipment, park lighting, BBQ grills, small and large dog parks and skate park.

On November 11th, the Council directed implementing the Police Services Transition Plan. This plan will transition police services from County Sheriff to a City forces.

Council awarded a contract to acquire skate park equipment for Wilson Park. It is expected to be installed this coming February.

The City has started planning for the 2024 Crawdad Festival to be held June 15th & 16th, 2024.
